DOMESTIC COTTON CROP SCENARIO

According to the report released by Pakistan Cotton Ginner's Association as on 1st February,2020 the arrivals of seed cotton into ginning factories witnessed decline of 20.0% to 8.487 million bales as compared to 10.606 million bales recorded in the corresponding period last year. The arrivals in Punjab declined by 22.4 percent to 5.014 million bales as compared to 6.461 million bales in last year.

Similarly, the arrivals in Sindh also remained decreased by 16.2 percent to 3.472 million bales as compared to 4.144 million bales in the same period of last year. The key factors of decline in production both in Punjab and Sindh were extra ordinary temperature rise (day and night) during the month of September,2019, thereby hampering the late season fruit development. Similarly, irrigation-water shortage in Sindh especially at critical stages of crop development, severe attack of Pink boll worm both in Punjab and Sindh, white fly attack and lower seed cotton prices with rising input costs remained key elements for affecting cotton production.

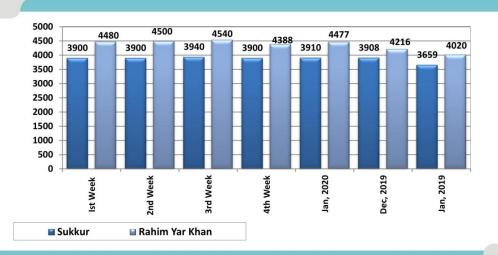

Figure-I: SEED COTTON PRICES DURING JANUARY, 2020

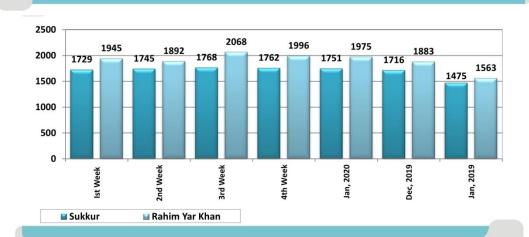

(Rs per 40 kg)

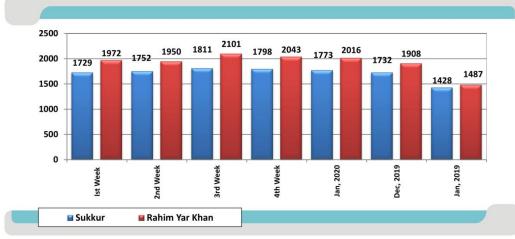

Figure-III: COTTON SEED CAKE PRICES DURING JANUARY, 2020

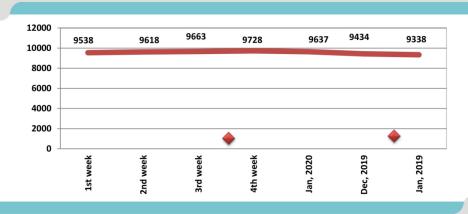

The table above indicates that the exports of raw cotton and it's related produce remained declined except synthetic fiber and knitwear during December,2019. The raw cotton exports decreased to 806 metric tons valuing Rs. 163 million as compared to 1,544 metric tons amounting to Rs. 321 million in November, 2019. However, the exports in December, 2018 recorded at 163 metric tons amounting to Rs. 40 million, showing decrease of 47.8 percent in quantity and 49.2 percent in value over November, 2019.

The table above shows that the imports of raw cotton during December, 2019 witnessed rising tendency to 14,620 metric tons amounting to Rs.3,703 million as compared to 8,990 metric tons valuing Rs.2,551 million in November,2019. Whereas the imports in December, 2018 recorded at 12,999 metric tons amounting to Rs.3,329 million, showing an increase of 62.62 percent in quantity and 45.15 percent in value over November, 2019.

ECONOMICS OF COTTON AND COMPETING CROPS

Cotton a Kharif crop, competes with rice, sugarcane and other crops for land, water and other farm resources in the area where the cultivation of all other crops is technically feasible. Mainly cotton faces indirect competition from sugarcane, the annual crop which keeps the land throughout the year. The economics of cotton and competing crops has been analyzed on the basis of inputs-outputs costs paid and received by the growers during 2016-17 year. The summary of various indicators for Punjab and Sindh are presented in table as under:

REGIONAL COTTON SITUATION

1. CHINA

Cotton area in China has declined by 2.0% to 3.300 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 3.367 million hectares in 2018-19. Reduction in yield also is expected due to high temperature and little rain. The production forecast in 2019-20 is 4% lower than the previous year. Similarly, consumption is expected to decline by 2.4% to 8.05 million tons in 2019-20. Imports by China are estimated at 1.810 million tons, showing a decrease of 13.8% over previous season. Stock levels in China continued to decline by 5.5% to 8.4 million tons in 2019-20.

2. INDIA

Cotton area in India is estimated to increase at 12.7 million hectares in 2019-20. Production in India is projected to grow by 12% to 6.0 million tons in 2019-20 owing to favorable weather conditions. Similarly, mill consumption is expected to rise by 2.5% to 5.535 million tons as compared to 5.400 million tons in 2018-19. Exports from India estimated to rise by 12.5 percent to 0.900 million tons in current year as compared to 0.800 million tons in previous year.

3. INTERNATIONAL COTTON SITUATION 2019-20

World cotton area is expected to grow by 2.0% to 33.624 million hectares in 2019-20 as compared to 32.963 million hectares in 2018-19. Global cotton production is expected to increase by 0.9% to 25.923 million tons, while consumption is projected to rise by 0.4% to 26.2 million tons. Global trade i.e imports and exports are estimated to decline at 9.4 million tons in 2019-20 as compared to 9.2 million tons in 2018-19. World ending stock levels are currently estimated to decrease by 1.5% by the end of 2019-20 under current estimates for production and consumption. With current projections of increase in global cotton production and weak consumption, cotton prices are expected to remain low in the new year.

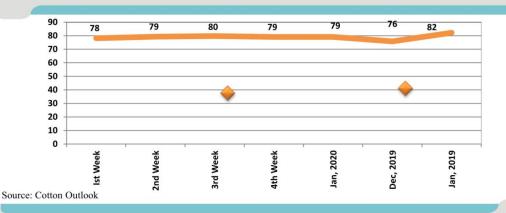

The graph above shows that 'A' index prices during January, 2020 posted nominal gains at 79.00 cents per pound as compared to 76.0 cents per pound in December, 2019. However, the prices in January, 2019 were recorded higher at 82.00 cents per pound. Month-wise details are given as below:

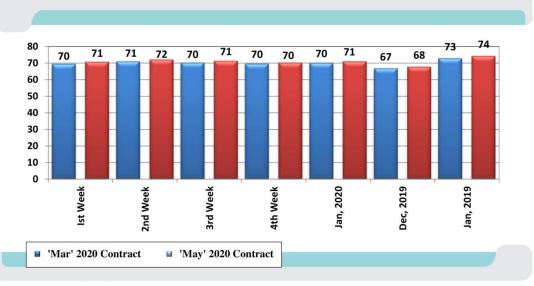
